 - ii) What has been your most engaging/most interesting learning experience this year?
- 2) **School Transcript:** To be eligible for consideration, returning applicants should have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Send a transcript to the email/address below. Final scholarship awards will be contingent upon receipt of a final, official school transcript in summer 2019, continued enrollment, and meeting the GPA requirements.
- 3) **Interview:** A phone or in-person interview will be scheduled upon receipt of your application.
